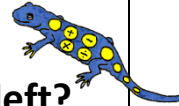
- 1) Mia had 34 marbles and found 10 more under the sofa. Now she has a big pile.

How many pebbles does the salamander have left?



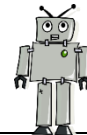
- 3) Ethan read 45 pages of his book on Monday and 10 pages on Tuesday. He wants to finish it soon.

How many leaves did he cross altogether?









- 7) Tom had 76 toy cars and bought 10 at a yard sale. His collection is getting huge.

<p>1) Mia had 34 marbles and found 10 more under the sofa. Now she has a big pile.</p> <p>How many marbles does she have now?</p> 	<p><u>$34 + 10 = 44$</u></p> <p><u>She has 44 marbles now.</u></p>
<p>2) Quadra salamander collected 28 shiny pebbles for her tiny cave. Then she gave 10 pebbles to a friend.</p> <p>How many pebbles does the salamander have left?</p> 	<p><u>$28 - 10 = 18$</u></p> <p><u>She has 18 pebbles left.</u></p>
<p>3) Ethan read 45 pages of his book on Monday and 10 pages on Tuesday. He wants to finish it soon.</p> <p>How many pages did he read in total?</p> 	<p><u>$45 + 10 = 55$</u></p> <p><u>He has read 55 pages in total.</u></p>
<p>4) A silly robot made 51 pancakes but accidentally ate 10 of them. It still felt hungry.</p> <p>How many pancakes are left?</p> 	<p><u>$51 - 10 = 41$</u></p> <p><u>There are 41 pancakes left.</u></p>
<p>5) Lila had 63 stickers and gave 10 to her classmates. She kept the rest in her sticker book.</p> <p>How many stickers does she have now?</p>	<p><u>$63 - 10 = 53$</u></p> <p><u>She has 53 stickers now.</u></p>
<p>6) A salamander raced across 19 leaves and then hopped across 10 more. He was very proud of himself.</p> <p>How many leaves did he cross altogether?</p> 	<p><u>$19 + 10 = 29$</u></p> <p><u>He has crossed 29 leaves in all.</u></p>
<p>7) Tom had 76 toy cars and bought 10 at a yard sale. His collection is getting huge.</p> <p>How many toy cars does Tom have now?</p> 	<p><u>$76 + 10 = 86$</u></p> <p><u>Tom has 86 cars now.</u></p>
