



10 MORE AND 10 LESS WORD PROBLEMS 2

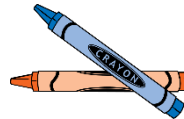
- 1) A group of kids collected 56 shells at the beach and later found 10 more. They washed them all in a bucket. **How many shells did they collect in total?**



- 2) A squirrel hid 95 acorns but a sneaky bird took 10 of them. The squirrel was not amused. **How many acorns does the squirrel have now?**



- 3) Jade had 48 crayons, but 10 of them broke during art class. She put the rest back in her box. **How many crayons not broken?**



- 4) Captain Salamander catches 17 fish before lunch. He catches 10 more after lunch. **How many fish does he have now?**



- 5) A bakery made 62 cupcakes in the morning and sold 10 by noon. **How many cupcakes are left?**



- 6) 59 children and 10 adults go on a school trip to a museum. **How many people go on the trip in all?**










- 7) A magician pulled 24 ribbons out of a hat, then made 10 of them vanish. **How many ribbons are there now?**





10 MORE AND 10 LESS WORD PROBLEMS 2 ANSWERS

1) A group of kids collected 56 shells at the beach and later found 10 more. They washed them all in a bucket. How many shells did they collect in total?	 <u>$56 + 10 = 66$</u> <u>They collected 66 shells in total.</u>
2) A squirrel hid 95 acorns but a sneaky bird took 10 of them. The squirrel was not amused. How many acorns does the squirrel have now?	 <u>$95 - 10 = 85$</u> <u>The squirrel has 85 acorns now.</u>
3) Jade had 48 crayons, but 10 of them broke during art class. She put the rest back in her box. How many crayons not broken?	 <u>$48 - 10 = 38$</u> <u>38 of the crayons are not broken</u>
4) Captain Salamander catches 17 fish before lunch. He catches 10 more after lunch. How many fish does he have now?	 <u>$17 + 10 = 27$</u> <u>He has 27 fish now.</u>
5) A bakery made 62 cupcakes in the morning and sold 10 by noon. How many cupcakes are left?	 <u>$62 - 10 = 52$</u> <u>There are 52 cupcakes left.</u>
6) 59 children and 10 adults go on a school trip to a museum. How many people go on the trip in all?	 <u>$59 + 10 = 69$</u> <u>There are 69 people on the trip.</u>
7) A magician pulled 24 ribbons out of a hat, then made 10 of them vanish. How many ribbons are there now?	 <u>$24 - 10 = 14$</u> <u>There are 14 ribbons now.</u>
