She adds 5 more fluid ounces of water.  
How much liquid is in the bottle now?



9) Captain reads 13 fiction and 7 non-fiction books in a month. How many books did he read in all?



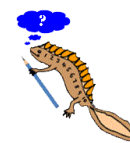
10) There are 19 books on one bookshelf and 7 books on another. What is the difference?

1)	There are 18 apples on a tree. Captain picks 14 of them. How many apples are left?		$18 - 14 = 4$ 4 apples
2)	Frazer cycles 12 miles. He has a rest. He cycles 7 more miles. How far has he cycled in total?		$12 + 7 = 19$ 19 miles
3)	Sally and Newton go crabbing. Sally catches 15 crabs. Newton catches 8 crabs. How many fewer crabs does Newton catch?		$15 - 8 = 7$ 7 fewer crabs
4)	Newton counts 5 snails on the ground and 14 snails eating plants. How many snails in all?		$5 + 14 = 19$ 19 snails
5)	On an egg hunt, Bob finds 8 eggs and Bill finds 9 eggs. How many eggs did they find altogether?		$8 + 9 = 17$ 17 eggs
6)	I flip a coin 20 times. It comes up heads 8 times. How many tails did I flip?		$20 - 8 = 12$ 12 tails
7)	There are 17 rabbits in a field. A loud noise scares 12 of them away. How many are left?		$17 - 12 = 5$ 5 rabbits
8)	There are 11 fluid ounces of water in Sally's bottle. She adds 5 more fluid ounces of water. How much liquid is in the bottle now?		$11 + 5 = 16$ 16 fluid ounces
9)	Captain reads 13 fiction and 7 non-fiction books in a month. How many books did he read in all?		$13 + 7 = 20$ 20 books
10)	There are 19 books on one bookshelf and 7 books on another. What is the difference?		$19 - 7 = 12$ 12 books
11)	There are 6 cars and 13 trucks in a parking lot. How many more trucks than cars?		$13 - 6 = 7$ 7 more
