

# THE IN-BETWEEN GAME # 1

*The in-between game is a simple dice game which involves using the roll of two dice to make a number between two different values.*

**Number of players:** 2+

**Learning:** making a total between two values up to 66, reading and writing 2-digit numbers.

**You will need**

- Two six-sided dice
- A pencil for each player

**Instructions**

- Each player will need their own pencil and an In-Between game board to start with.
- The first player rolls the two dice and uses the digits to make a 2-digit number. The number can be written either way round, so a 3 and a 4 could be combined to make 34 or 43.
- The player then writes the two-digit number in any place on their In-Between board where the number could fit.
- The next player then has their turn.
- If a player cannot make a number that will fit into a free place on their board, then play passes to the next player.
- The first player to complete their board is the winner.

**Example**

Player 1 rolls a 2 and a 5. They rearrange and combine the numbers to make 52. They write the number in the 'In Between 40 and 55' section of their board.

**Variations**

- Roll one dice twice – the first roll is the tens digit; the second roll is the ones digit (no rearranging the digits). This makes the game harder to play.
- Allow each player to have 3 special 'roll again' counters. If a player cannot go, they can choose to play one of their 'roll again' counters and roll the dice one more time and see if they can make one of the numbers needed.

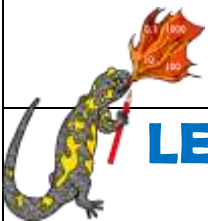
